Why Exhibit at MICS 2020?


The MICS program and conference layout are designed for maximum interaction between attendees and exhibitors:

- Drawings and other incentives for attendees to engage with exhibitors


Who Attends MICS?


MICS program content covers an array of mucosal tissues, attracting delegates from across disciplines and practice settings, including:

Scientific Program at MICS 2020

The program will feature more than 40 scientists and approximately 100 poster presenters. Faculty and oral abstract presenters will share their latest research in areas including:

- Mucosal vaccines
- Nanoparticle respiratory virus

- Pulmonary epithelia




Charging Station: \$10,000
